# Why should I secure my wireless network?

Wireless networks are more flexible than wired ones, but they can also be more vulnerable to hackers or malicious software (such as worms). Because wireless networks use radio waves that can pass through walls, your network's signal could go beyond the boundaries of your home. If you don't try to secure your network, people with computers nearby might be able to access the information stored on your network computers and use your Internet connection to get onto the web. By setting up a security key on your wireless network, you can help protect it from unauthorized access.

# Take Precautions with Personal Information

To avoid becoming a victim of identity theft, pay attention to what's in your wallet, purse, mailbox, and trash. These are the places that criminals look to find the personal information needed to assume your identity, apply for credit in your name, and gain access to your bank accounts.

#### **Consider What You Carry**

- Memorize your PINs and passwords. Do not write them down and put them in your wallet or purse.
- Carry only personal identification and the credit cards you actually need on a daily basis.
- Never carry your Social Security card with you and do not have your Social Security number printed on your checks.

#### **Manage Your Mailbox**

- Do not leave bill payment envelopes clipped to your mailbox or inside with the flag up. Criminals may steal your outgoing mail.
- Know your billing cycles, and watch for any missing mail. An identity thief may have filed a change-ofaddress request in your name with the creditor or the post office.
- Carefully review your monthly bills and credit card statements for unauthorized charges as soon as you receive them. If you suspect unauthorized use, contact the provider's customer service and fraud departments immediately.

#### **Take Care With Trash**

- Shred all bank statements and unused pre-approved credit card offers before throwing them away at home.
- When you are out, keep track of receipts from credit cards, debit cards, and ATM transactions. Never throw them in a public trash container.
