What is Fiber to the Home?

Fiber to the Home (FTTH) refers to the installation and use of fiber optic cables to carry digital information directly to homes and businesses. These cables are made up of hundreds or thousands of fiber optics, which are long thin strands of pure glass about the diameter of a human hair.

FTTH replaces the duplicate infrastructure that telephone and cable companies previously installed in neighborhoods. Fiber has a higher bandwidth capacity and can easily transmit applications like telephone and Internet with plenty of capacity left over for other applications in the future.

Will anything need to be installed at my house?

Yes, one Optical Network Terminal will be installed outside of your home, likely near the NID where your telephone service is currently terminated. This cabinet contains the electronics that convert a signal of light from the fiber into usable phone and Internet. We will also install a power supply wiring and battery backup in your basement or utility room in case of power outage.

On a related matter, please remember when you work with our technicians to carefully choose the locations for your network jacks. Take into consideration where you will be placing your televisions, computers, and other electronics that require access to the Internet. If you choose to move these jacks in the future, additional wiring installation will cost you approximately \$60 per hour.
