La Porte City Specialty Care

La Porte City Specialty Care is a 46 bed, not-for-profit nursing facility providing skilled rehabilitation, long-term care, hospice care and outpatient services. They employ 55 employees and partner with Reliant Rehabilitation for physical, occupational, and speech therapy services for inpatients and outpatients of all ages. Originally named Colonial Manor, this facility has been in business since 1966. The new facility, built in 2004 appears more as a weekend getaway for patients rather than a rehabilitation center.
